Important Summer Learning Opportunity

We are just getting results back from our end-of-year assessments and are seeing some very promising growth in our students – especially those who participated faithfully in the Moby Max and Simple Solutions program this year. We have multiple opportunities for those students who want to continue that climb without the traditional summer slide.

Summer Adventures in Reading and Math will be offered again this year. Classes will run from **1:00 to 3:30 pm, Mondays through Thursdays**, during the last 3 weeks of July and will be taught by Miss Harris, Mrs. Russell and Mrs. Roberson. Enrollment forms were sent home last week and are available in the office. This program will be more focused on specific skills students need for the next grade level and teachers will be making recommendations for students that would benefit from a jump start before next year.
